**Local Law No. 2 of the year 2009**

**A local law** rezoning 196.74 ± acres of land located at 1035 Loudon Road and 418 Boght Road from a Single Family Residential (SFR) District to a Planned Development District (PDD) to be known as Canterbury Crossing.

**Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Colonie of as follows:**

**SECTION 1.**

The following described area consisting of 196.74 ± acres of land located at 1035 Loudon Road and 418 Boght Road is hereby rezoned from Single Family Residential District (SFR) to Planned Development District (PDD):

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND situate in the Town of Colonie, County of Albany, and State of New York more particularly described on the Albany County Tax Map as Section 9.4, Block 2, Lot 1 (1035 Loudon Road) and Section 10.3, Block 1, Lot 4 (418 Boght Road) as depicted upon the map attached hereto.

**SECTION 2. ZONING MAP**

Section 190-4(B)(1) of the Code of the Town of Colonie is amended by modifying the “Town of Colonie Zoning Map” described therein to reclassify those lands described in Section 1 above from a Single family Residential zoning district to a Planned Development District. Said map shall be modified and a copy of the revised map shall be filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Colonie.

**SECTION 3. CONDITIONS**

The subject 196.74 ± acre parcel described in Section 1 above is rezoned to a Planned Development District upon the condition that it be developed as a mixed-use complex including 77 single family lots, 60 “Estate” condominium units, 92 “Villa” condominium units, 42 carriage homes, 58 Senior Citizen condominium units, 6,000 square feet of retail space, 30,000 square feet of office space, and 105.78 ± acres of open space, as more fully detailed in the narrative description, plans, and additional materials provided with the request for rezoning and filed in the office of the Town Clerk.

#### SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect upon its proper filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
