Local Law No. 1 of the year 2010

A local law amending Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, entitled "Fire Lanes"

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Colonie of as follows:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

100 Forest Drive

1. Starting at a point eighteen feet plus or minus (18' +/-) south of the southeast corner of the building now or formerly known as Forest Park School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide and extending for a distance of two hundred sixty eight feet plus or minus (268' +/-) in a westerly direction.
2. Starting at a point twenty feet plus or minus (20' +/-) south and thirty feet plus or minus (30' +/-) west of the southwest corner of the building now or formerly known as Forest Park School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide and extending for a distance of two hundred two feet plus or minus (202' +/-) in a northerly direction. Eight feet plus or minus (58'+/-) in a northeasterly direction. From that point extending a distance of seventy-six feet plus or minus (76'+/-) in a northwesterly direction.
3. Starting at a point forty feet plus or minus (40' +/-) south of the southeast corner of the building now or formerly known as Sears. An area fifteen feet plus or minus (15' +/-) wide, and extending for a distance of forty eight feet plus or minus (48' +/-) in a southeasterly direction.

SECTION 2.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

100 Hackett Ave.

1. Starting at a point forty six feet plus or minus (46' +/-) east of the northeast corner of the building now or formerly known as Colonie Central High School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide and extending for a distance of six hundred forty six feet (646' +/-) plus or minus in a southerly direction.
2. Starting at a point forty four feet plus or minus (44' +/-) east and forty six feet plus or minus (46' +/-) east of the southeast corner of the building now or formerly known as the Multi Use Gymnasium (MUG), an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide, extending for a distance of two hundred twelve feet plus or minus (212' +/-), in a westerly direction.

SECTION 3.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

25 Veeder Dr.

1. Starting at a point twelve feet plus or minus (12' +/-) south of the southwest corner of the building now or formerly known as Veeder Elementary School. An area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-), wide, and extending for a distance of forty eight feet plus or minus (48' +/-), in a southerly direction. From that point, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-), wide and extending for a distance of one hundred fifty feet plus or minus (150' +/-), in a westerly direction. From that point an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide and extending for a distance of fifty feet plus or minus (50' +/-) in a northwesterly direction.
2. Starting at a point fourteen feet plus or minus (14' +/-), south of the southwest corner of the southernmost portion of the building now or formerly known as Veeder Elementary School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-), wide and extending a distance of two hundred twenty two feet plus or minus (222' +/-) in a westerly direction.

SECTION 4.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

100 California Avenue

1. Starting at a point twenty six feet plus or minus (26' +/-) south and forty-four feet plus or minus (44' +/-) east of the southeast corner of the building now or formerly known as Roessleville Elementary School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide, extending for a distance of two hundred thirty six feet plus or minus (236' +/-) in a westerly direction.

SECTION 5.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

329 Sand Creek Rd.

1. Starting at a point thirty feet plus or minus (30' +/-) south of the southeast corner of the building now or formerly known as Sand Creek Middle School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide, extending for a distance of three hundred twenty eight feet plus or minus (328' +/-) in a westerly direction. From that point an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide, extending for a distance of four hundred fifty two feet plus or minus (452' +/-) in a northerly direction.

SECTION 6.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

102 Loralee Dr.

1. Starting at a point 84 feet plus or minus (84' +/-) south of the southwest corner of the building now or formerly known as Saddlewood School, an area twenty four feet (24' +/-) wide, extending for a distance of two hundred eighty six feet plus or minus (286' +/-) in an easterly direction.

SECTION 7.

Chapter 97 of the Code of the Town of Colonie, Section 97-10 is hereby amended by adding the following:

§97-10 -Fire lanes amended.

512 Albany Shaker Rd.

1. Starting at a point twelve feet plus or minus (12' +/-), north, and thirty four feet plus or minus (34' +/-), east, of the northeast corner of the building now or formerly known as Shaker Road Elementary School, an area twenty four feet plus or minus (24' +/-) wide, and extending for a distance of two hundred eighty feet plus or minus (280' +/-) in a southerly direction.

SECTION 8.

This local law shall become effective upon its proper filing with the Secretary of State.
