

## **Conservation Advisory Council (CAC) Opening**

There is currently an opening for a Colonie resident to serve as a member of the Town's Conservation Advisory Council (CAC). The CAC meets at 7:00 p.m. on the first and third Thursday of each month in the Supervisor's Conference Room on the second floor of Memorial Town Hall.

The CAC maintains the Town's open space inventory, promotes interest in the environment through bulletin board displays, public relations, and educational presentations. It supports efforts involved with the acquisition of environmentally significant properties located within the Town.

The CAC also coordinates and assists in the Town's Conservation Day and Hazardous Waste Day programs.

Membership on the CAC provides compensation of \$1,490 per year and requires a significant time commitment.
