

Upcoming Vacancy on the Significant Environmental Areas Management Appeals Board

There will be an opening for a Colonie resident to serve on the Significant Environmental Areas Management Appeals Board (SEAMAB).

The Significant Environmental Areas Management Appeals Board hears and decides appeals regarding administration or enforcement of the Town's watercourse area management provisions and applications for watercourse-related variances. SEAMAB meets once a month at 7:00 p.m. at the Town's Public Operations Center.

It is the Town's goal to encourage proactive planning and development of the natural and man-made watercourses and adjacent lands in the Town of Colonie in ways that will restore, protect, develop, and enhance their benefits.

Membership on SEAMAB provides compensation of \$1,325 per year.
