STEP 1:

The walk will take place on Saturday, May 8. Walker packet pickup will take place at the South Pavilion, and various educational activities will happen throughout the park. Come when you can, stay as long as you'd like, and enjoy the park!

STEP 3:

If you choose to do the walk virtually please complete step 1 and a walker packet will be mailed to you.

Walker registration is FREE, must be completed by 5:00pm on **Thursday, May 6**, and donations of any size are welcome.
