NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF COLONIE

(Route 9)

The Latham Water District has awarded a contract to Peter Luizzi and Bros. Contracting Inc. for the installation of 2,150 feet of 12-inch ductile iron water main and high-density polyethylene (HDPE) main along NYS Route 9 (Loudon Road) from Town Hall to Campus View Drive and along NYS Route 9 from Spring Street to Turner Lane. This new water main will replace an existing 10" cast iron main that has shown an increase in breaks recently. Once the project is completed, service to residents will be improved by increasing system reliability, pressure and available fire flows.

Construction is expected to begin on Monday March 19th, 2018 and be completed by the end of July 2018. During Construction residents are urged to seek alternate travel routes if possible to avoid travel delays.

Since the new water main on NYS Route 9 (Loudon Road) will be installed in virtually the same location as the existing main, temporary, above-ground water mains will be installed to supply the affected residents along NYS Route 9 (Loudon Road). The above-ground temporary water mains will likely connect to the resident's water service curb stops and cross existing driveways at the Town's right-of-way boundary. The contractor will either saw cut the asphalt driveway aprons within the right-of-way to bury the temporary water mains or install crushed stone ramps to protect them from damage. If the contractor installs a crushed stone ramp at the driveway crossing, we request that residents take care when driving over the temporary water mains. If the contractor saw cuts their asphalt driveway apron, it will be restored at the end of the project.
