Town of Colonie Municipal Buildings Open by Appointment Only

Supervisor Paula Mahan has announced that as of Monday, December 7, 2020, the Town of Colonie Municipal Buildings will be open by appointment only. Supervisor Mahan stated, “As a community, we have done a great job in preventing the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Unfortunately, with the recent increase of cases, we need to take further measures to continue to protect the health and safety of our community.”

Anyone needing to conduct business with the town should contact the specific department and make an appointment. A list of departments and contact information can be found by visiting our website at www.colonie.org.

We encourage visits to the town buildings be limited to essential business needs only. If business can be conducted online, we encourage everyone to do so by visiting the respective department web pages or contacting the specific department via phone or email. If you choose to visit us, you must make an appointment and pay attention to all signage. Facemasks are required, practice good hand hygiene and remember to keep the six feet social distancing.

The Public Safety Building will remain open. Follow the regulations posted on the entrance doors to ensure everyone’s safety.

The William K. Sanford Town Library will allow a maximum of 15 people in the building for 15 minutes to browse and check out material and/or use an express computer. Curbside pickup is also available.

The town parks remain open to the public to use the outdoor trails. Anyone using the parks should adhere to social distancing and wear a mask while in the park.
