On March 3, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., the Town of Colonie, in conjunction with the Villages of Colonie and Menands, will hold a virtual public hearing via Zoom Meeting. The hearing will be for the purpose of reviewing program performance and obtaining the views of citizens on what projects should be included in the Town's 2021-2022 Entitlement Action Plan.

It is anticipated that total 2021 funding will be approximately \$425,000 in federal monies including \$325,000 in block grant funds and \$100,000 in HOME funds for use on projects that are eligible under the Community Development Block Grant and HOME Programs and were prioritized in the Five Year Consolidated Plan adopted June 4, 2020. These funds may be used for any eligible project located in the Town of Colonie, Village of Colonie, and Village of Menands.

Those attending the hearing will review the program performance and will be able to recommend projects to be included in the Entitlement Action Plan.

All citizens of the Town of Colonie, Village of Colonie, and Village of Menands are encouraged to attend this public hearing.
